6. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation permits the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Accreditation must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. During the accreditation the Heads of Delegation have to verify the identity of the members of their delegation as well as all requirements regarding accommodation, meals and registrations. They have to make the necessary payments (including insurance), hand over the CDs for the exercises of their athletes, the CD with the national anthem and their national flag. **The Organising Committee suggests to all Federation to bring CDs.**

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. The accreditation place will be in ROMEXPO Central Pavillion.

The accreditation is personal, non-transferable and necessary for access to the training and competition halls, as well as for official transports. The FIG and UEG Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially with regard to the number of persons accredited per nation.

Accreditations are provided for each delegation having fulfilled their financial obligations. In order to get the accreditation passes quickly we need digital photos (passport format) of all members of your delegation as follows:

- The size of each photo should be about 100 Kb (please send no photos of more Kb's or even Mb's).
- We can only handle photos in .jpg or .gif format.
- The name of the person shall be part of the file name.

Delegations which have sent the passport photos of all delegation members in time to <http://www.romgym.ro/ec2011aerobic/> - section registration on-line have priority at the accreditation desk. Deadline for receiving the passport photos is 19th of October, 2011.

6.1 MUSICAL ACCOMPANIMENT

In order to simplify the management of the music and to limit the technical problems of wiring for sound during the competitions, the Organizing Committee wishes to reduce the variety of the various musical supports (CD, key USB) and use only the numerical support.

Each music will be classified and indexed in a file on the computers of wiring for sound by respecting the flow schedule in order to be able to use them quickly and effectively.

All the music used during the 7th Aerobics Gymnastics European Championships must be submitted online to: <http://www.romgym.ro/ec2011aerobic/> - section registration on-line until 19th October 2011.

The Organizing Committee wishes to receive the gymnasts' music in MP3 format.

Each music will have to contain following information:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR);
- The Junior or Senior (Example: ROU_RADU_Alina_Junior_IW2_ mp3)

The Head of delegation or the coach has to sign two forms in the name of the competitor in order to:

- approve the technical criteria for playing the CDs by the organiser;
- guarantee and as a discharge indicating that the pieces of music chosen are not forbidden to be played, including during a sports event.

At the Accreditation the Heads of delegation have to give the Music Release (App. D).

During the training sessions, the competitors have to use their personal CD (3rd copy).

6.2 LIST OF DIFFICULTY ELEMENTS

At the accreditation, the Heads of delegation have to give the list of difficulty elements (appendix C) for each competitor(s) by each category (Seniors and Juniors).

6.3 NATIONAL ANTHEMS AND FLAGS

At the accreditation the Heads of delegation have to give the CD with the national anthem and the national flag (app. 180 cm x 90 cm) to the OC.

6.4 FIG LICENSES

All gymnasts willing to take part in the 7th Aerobic Gymnastics European Championships must have valid personal FIG license. All licenses are only issued by the FIG Secretariat on the basis of data received from national federations.

The licenses' applications must be made one (1) month at the very latest prior to the validity date required in order to be considered by the FIG. All national federations which still did not apply for licenses are kindly requested to do it as soon as possible. No licenses' requests will be handled while on site and no exceptions will be made. During competitions FIG licenses are to be basic proof for issuing accreditations. They will be checked at the accreditation.

7. VISAS

Please check whether you need a visa to gain entry in Romania. The Organising Committee will assist you applying for a visa with pleasure. To assist with the application process, each country should complete the attached visa request form. This form has to be sent back to the Organising Committee by 23rd of September 2011 at the latest.

8. INSURANCE

The FIG and UEG Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations have to assume all costs in relation to the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Organising Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy).

Participating in the European Championships without valid medical insurance of all delegation members will be rejected. However, those delegations which cannot present valid medical insurance, delegation members will have the possibility to conclude a medical insurance service at the ROMEXPO Central Pavillion – accreditation desk, provided by the OC.

9. ORIENTATION MEETING

This orientation meeting for all delegations will take place on Wednesday, 9 November, 10.00 hrs at ROMEXPO Central Pavillion - Cupola Hall.

The Heads of Delegation, Coaches and Judges have to participate in this briefing session, during which the UEG delegates, the UEG AER TC and the OC will give information about the running of the championships. An updated work plan will be handed to the Heads of delegation during the orientation meeting.

The participation of the HoD in the orientation meeting is compulsory; in case of a no-show, the federation concerned has to pay a fine.

Any advertisement displayed on leotard must be approved at orientation meeting (according to the UEG rules of publicity). This orientation meeting will be held in English only.

10. TRAINING – WARM UP

The training will start on Wednesday, 9th November 2011 and will take place in the training halls and competition hall of the ROMEXPO Exhibitions Centre.

A detailed timetable for the warming-up will be handed to the Heads of delegation upon arrival.

Only the specific warming-up hall will be equipped with 2 official Janssen & Fritsen floors.

The timetable of the training and the warming-up of the finalists will be given to the Heads of delegation on Saturday evening 12th November 2011 for Junior and Seniors.

The access to the competition hall, the training and the warming-up halls will only be granted to those delegations wearing the accreditation card and only during the times reserved for their nation.

11. DRAWING OF LOTS AND STARTING ORDER

The drawing of lots for the starting order of the qualifications has taken place in Budapest, August 10th, 2011.

Please note that the order indicated on the nominative entry form will determine the place of the competitor(s) and the number of the draw (starting list). No changes will be allowed.

The order of all categories for competitions in the qualifications will be:

- 1st part IW & TR
- 2nd part IM / MP & GR

The order of all categories for competitions in the finals will be:

- IW, IM, MP, TR & GR

The starting order for the finals will be established according to the dispositions of the UEG Technical Rules and FIG Code of Points.

The list of the finalists, with two reserves, will be handed over to the head of delegation after each qualification.

12. OFFICIAL FLOOR

The competition podium and training hall have FIG official floors from Janssen & Fritsen.

13. JUDGES' BRIEFINGS

All judges have to participate in the briefing sessions as described in the General Programme (5.). All sessions will be held in English. Short judges' briefings will take place before each competition. They are compulsory for all appointed judges and reserves.

15. DRAWING OF LOTS OF THE JUDGES

The composition of the judge's panels for the qualifications and finals will be drawn from the judges list, nominated by the participating national federations.

16. RESULTS

Complete statement of the results will be distributed to the federations at the end of the ECh, including the marks awarded by each judge.

17. PROTESTS / INQUIRIES

Inquiries for the difficulty scores are allowed, provided that they are presented verbally immediately to the Supervisor Administrator after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the end of the exercise of the following gymnast or group. The Supervisor Administrator to receive the verbal inquiry has to note the time of receiving it and this starts the procedure.

Late verbal inquires will be rejected. A federation is not allowed to complain against a gymnast from another federation.

The delegations will be exactly informed about the procedure of inquiries at the Orientation meeting.

19. MEDICAL CENTRE

The OC will provide the necessary medical services.

20. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be carried out during the European Championships, in accordance with the FIG and IOC Regulations. They could be carried out during the training, qualifications and/or final competitions.

21. MOBILE PHONES

During the entire competition, the gymnasts, judges and coaches are absolutely prohibited from using mobile phones and other electronic communications device.

22. CONTROL VIDEO

Only the host broadcaster's cameras as well as UEG cameras are allowed in the competition hall. Video recording is not permitted in the competition venue. At the end of each competition day all TC members must receive one copy for judges analyse.

23. SEATS FOR THE DELEGATIONS

Seats will be reserved for each participating delegation.

24. OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY

The Official Opening ceremony will be held on Friday, 11th November for Juniors and Saturday, 12th November for Seniors in ROMEXPO – Central Pavillion - Competition hall. The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing 2 x 8 counts with aerobics music. The rehearsal will be held on Wednesday, 9th November, 18.30 hrs in ROMEXPO – Central Pavillion - Competition Hall - Podium. All Heads of Delegation & Coaches must be present during the Rehearsal of Opening Ceremony. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit.

25. MEDAL AWARD CEREMONIES

The award ceremonies will be organised immediately after the finals (see the schedule). Only the medallists will participate and they must wear the **competition attire**.

26. FAREWELL PARTY

The closing evening will be organised on Sunday night with time and venue to be confirmed upon arrival. Accreditation will be asked for access.

27. TRANSPORTS

The OC will organise transport for the delegations from Bucharest International Airport to Bucharest, from Bucharest Train and Bucharest Bus Station to the official hotels and to the competition venue. The transports schedule between competition hall and the official hotels will be available upon arrival of the delegations at the accreditation office.

Airport transport service from Bucharest will be provided by the Organising Committee to delegations which book their accommodation through the Organising Committee and return their travel information form by 23rd September 2011 at the latest.

Only accredited persons are entitled to use the transportation system.

28. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the Championships is English. The Championships will be conducted in English.

29. MEDIA PRESS CONFERENCE

The official press conference with the medallists will take place for competitors on Sunday after the Medal award ceremonies.

During the orientation meeting, you will receive detailed information on a possible press conference.

30. HOTELS

Reservations for accommodation and meal must be made using the online-registration.

The Organising Committee has offered packages for all delegations.

Should the chosen category not be available, the Organising Committee will contact the Federation to discuss alternative options.

The packages include full board (breakfast and dinner which is available in your hotel, and the Organising Committee will arrange lunch for the members of the delegations at venue ROMEXPO Exhibitions Centre).
