6. ACCREDITATION

COMPULSORY LICENCE/GYMNASTICS PASSPORT

All Gymnasts, juniors and seniors need to own a personal licence. These licences are established by the FIG (FIG Licence Rules were already transmitted to all Federations) and are the basis document for elaborating the accreditation.

All Gymnasts (Juniors and Seniors) must therefore present a valid FIG Licence in order to be entitled to participate at these European Championships.

The Licence must be presented and checked upon accreditation. Gymnasts who do not present a valid FIG Licence are not allowed to compete.

Should a gymnast not be able to show his/her licence at accreditation, the Organising Committee will check on the official FIG Website if the respective gymnast has a valid licence or not. If this can be verified in due time by the Organising Committee, the gymnast may participate in the competition by paying a fee of CHF 20,00 to the Organising Committee.

Accreditation permits the identification of all participants and indicates the access to certain zones. Access to all zones will be controlled. Accreditation must be visibly worn throughout the whole event. During the accreditation the Heads of Delegation have to verify the identity of the members of their delegation as well as all requirements regarding accommodation, meals and registrations. They have to make the necessary payments (including insurance), hand over the tapes or CDs for the exercises of their athletes, the tape or CD with the national anthem and their national flag. **The Organising Committee suggests to all Federation to bring CDs.**

Accreditation will be carried out upon arrival. The accreditation place will be in Tipsport Arena.

The accreditation is personal, non-transferable and necessary for access to the training and competition halls, as well as for official transports. The FIG and UEG Directives and Technical Regulations will be strictly applied, especially with regard to the number of persons accredited per nation.

Accreditations are provided for each delegation has fulfilled their financial obligations. In order to get the accreditation passes quickly we need digital passport photos of all members of your delegation as follows:

- Every photo's size should be about 100 Kb (please send no photos of more Kb's or even Mb's).
- We can only handle photos in .jpg or .gif format.
- The name of the person shall be part of the file name.

Delegations which have sent the passport photos of all delegation members in time to cqf@cstv.cz have priority at the accreditation desk. Deadline for receiving the passport photos is 31st of October, 2009.

6.1 MUSICAL ACCOMPANIMENT

Upon arrival, the delegations have to supply the OC with two audio tapes or CD's according to the dispositions of the code of points. The following information has to be written on these tapes or CD's:

- The name of the nation (official abbreviation of the country);
- The first and last name of the competitor/s;
- The category (IM, IW, MP, TR, GR);
- The Junior or Senior and/or competition designation;

The Head of Delegation or the Coach has to sign two forms in the name of the competitor in order to:

- approve the technical criteria for playing the tapes or CDs by the organiser;
- guarantee and as a discharge indicating that the pieces of music chosen are not forbidden to be played, including during a sports event.

At the Accreditation the Heads of delegation have to give the Music Release (App.D)

During the training sessions, the competitors have to use their personal CD (3rd copy).

6.2 LIST OF DIFFICULTY ELEMENTS

At the accreditation, the Heads of Delegation have to give the list of difficulty elements (appendix C) for each competitor(s) by each category (Seniors and Juniors).

6.3 NATIONAL ANTHEMS AND FLAGS

At the accreditation the Heads of Delegation have to give tapes or CD's with the national anthem and the national flag (app. 180 cm x 90 cm) to the OC.

7. VISAS

Please check whether you need a visa to gain entry into Czech Republic. The Organising Committee will assist you applying for a visa with pleasure. To assist with the application process, each country should complete the attached visa request form. This form has to be sent back to the Organising Committee by 30th of September 2009 at the latest.

8. INSURANCE

The FIG and UEG Technical Regulations stipulate that all participating federations have to assume all costs in relation to the medical insurance of all delegation members (illness and accidents). The Organising Committee has the right to verify the validity of the insurance upon arrival of the delegations (policy insurance, original or copy).

Entering to the European Championships without valid medical insurance of all delegation members will be rejected. However, those delegations which cannot present valid medical insurance, delegation members will have the possibility to conclude a medical insurance service at the Tipsport Arena provided by the OC.

9. ORIENTATION MEETING

This orientation Meeting for all delegations will take place on Wednesday, 18th November, 10.00 hrs at Tipsport Arena, Restaurant Colosseum.

The Heads of Delegation, Coaches and Judges have to participate in this briefing session, during which the UEG AER TC and the OC will give information about the running of the championships. An updated work plan will be handed to the Heads of Delegation during the orientation meeting.

Any advertisement displayed on leotard must be approved at orientation meeting (according to the new UEG rules for Advertising and publicity, which comes into operation on September 1st, 2009). This orientation meeting will be held in English only.

10. TRAINING – WARM UP

The training will start on Wednesday, 18th November, and will take place in the training halls and competition hall of the Tipsport Arena.

A detailed timetable for the warming-up will be handed to the Heads of Delegation upon arrival.

Only the specific warming-up hall will be equipped with 2 official Gymnova floors.

The timetable of the training and the warming-up of the finalists will be given to the Heads of Delegation on Friday evening 20th November 2009 for Juniors.

The timetable of the training and the warming-up of the finalists will be given to the Heads of Delegation on Saturday evening 21st November 2009 for Seniors.

The access to the competition hall, the training and the warming-up halls will only be granted to those delegations wearing the accreditation card and only during the times reserved for their nation.

11. DRAWING OF LOTS AND STARTING ORDER

The drawing of lots for the starting order of the qualifications will take place in Rome, 23rd August 2009.

Please note that the order indicated on the nominative entry form will determine the place of the competitor(s) and the number of the draw (starting list). No changes will be allowed.

The order of all categories for all competitions (qualifications & finals) will be:

- 1st Part IW & TR
- 2nd Part IM / MP & GR

The starting order for the finals will be established according to the dispositions of the UEG Technical Rules and FIG Code of Points.

The list of the finalists, with two reserves, will be handed over to the head of delegation after each qualification.

12. OFFICIAL FLOOR

The competition podium and training hall have FIG official floors Gymnova.

13. JUDGES BRIEFINGS

All judges have to participate in the briefing sessions as described in the General Programme (5.). All sessions will be held in English. Short Judges Briefings will take place before each competition. They are compulsory for all appointed judges and reserves.

15. DRAWING OF LOTS OF THE JUDGES

The composition of the judge's panels for the qualifications and finals will be drawn from the judges list, nominated by the participating national federations.

16. RESULTS

Complete statement of the results will be distributed to the Federations at the end of the ECh, including the marks awarded by each judge.

17. PROTESTS / INQUIRIES

Inquiries for the difficulty scores are allowed, provided that they are presented verbally immediately to the Supervisor Administrator after the publication of the score or at the very latest before the end of the exercise of the following gymnast or group. The Supervisor Administrator to receive the verbal inquiry has to note the time of receiving it and this starts the procedure.

Late verbal inquires will be rejected. A federation is not allowed to complain against a gymnast from another federation.

The Delegations will be exactly informed about the procedure of inquiries at the Orientation meeting.

19. MEDICAL CENTRE

The OC will provide the necessary medical services.

20. DOPING CONTROLS

Doping control will be carried out during the European Championships, in accordance with the FIG and IOC Regulations. They could be carried out during the training, qualifications and/or final competitions.

21. CONTROL VIDEO

Only the Host Broadcaster's cameras as well as UEG cameras are allowed in the Competition Hall. Video recording is not permitted in the Competition Venue.

22. SEATS FOR THE DELEGATIONS

Seats will be reserved for each participating delegation.

23. OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY

The Official Opening ceremony will be held on Friday, 20th November for Juniors and Saturday, 21st November for Seniors in Tipsport Arena Competition Hall. The ceremony will consist of Flags Presentation by nation with the competitors by nation performing 2 x 8 counts with aerobics music. The rehearsal will be held on Wednesday 18th 18.30 hrs in Tipsport Arena Competition Hall - Podium. All Head of Delegation & Coaches must be present during the Rehearsal of Opening Ceremony. All competitors must wear their national tracksuit.

24. MEDAL AWARD CEREMONIES

The award ceremonies will be organised immediately after the finals (see the schedule). Only the medallists will participate and they must wear the **competition attire**.

25. FAREWELL PARTY

The closing evening will be organised on Sunday night with time and venue to be confirmed upon arrival. Accreditation will be asked for access.

26. TRANSPORTS

The OC will organise transport for the delegations from Prague International Airport to Liberec, from Liberec Train and Liberec Bus Station to the official hotels and to the Tipsport Arena. The transports schedule between Tipsport Arena and the official hotels will be informed upon arrival of the delegations at the accreditation office.

Airport transport service from Prague (90 km from Liberec) will be provided by the Organising Committee to delegations which book their accommodation through the Organising Committee and return their travel information form by September 30th, 2009 at the latest.

Only accredited persons are entitled to use the transportation system.

27. OFFICIAL LANGUAGE

The official language of the Championships is English. The Championships will be conducted in English. The present work-plan will be in English.

28. MEDIA PRESS CONFERENCE

The official press conference with the medallists will take place for competitors on Sunday after the Medal award ceremonies.

29. HOTELS

Reservations for accommodation and meal must be made with the official forms.

The Organising Committee has offered packages for all delegations.

Should the chosen category not be available, the Organising Committee will contact the Federation to discuss alternative options.

The packages include full board (breakfast and dinner which is available in your hotel, and the Organising Committee will arrange lunch for the members of the delegations at venue Tipsport Arena).
